


### Rhythm of the Dance Show at Hodjapasha In Istanbul






### Turkish Calligraph Experience in Istanbul

# ( Street tour for food lovers, The Turkish way of doing it...)

Istanbul also offers a wide array of regional and specialty Turkish dishes. Here are a few that you should definitely sample, many of which can be found on the street or on a Turkish food tour.

Kebabs - Do Turkish kebabs really need an introduction? Kebab dishes are popular throughout the Western world, particularly in Europe due to the large number of Turkish immigrants. These delicate chunks of meat are roasted or grilled on a skewer or spit and are served in a number of ways throughout Istanbul, the most popular being on a half loaf of bread or in a wrap mixed with veggies and french fries.

Cig Köfte - Çiğ Köfte (pronounced chee kooftey) literally means 'raw meatball'. In the past these were made with raw minced beef or lamb meat. Although still prevalent in the southeast, raw meatballs are pretty much outlawed in western Turkey. The one's you will be encountering are made of bulgur wheat, onions, scallions, parsley, green pepper and probably tomato sauce, served on a sheath of lettuce with a lemon slice.

Midye - You will find little pyramids of midye (mussels) on the streets all around Istanbul. Perennially popular, they are an essential element of Turkish food culture and served fried on skewers and eaten with garlic sauce, or (even better) served stuffed with spiced rice, pine nuts and sometimes raisins and then served to you by a man who personally squeezes a jet of lemon juice inside.

Hamsi - Anchovies, or 'hamsi,' are little fish roughly the size of a finger. They are served fried and whole (eyeballs, tailfin, everything) in a generous pile on a platter, or mixed with rice in a dish called "hamsilipilav" (anchovy rice). The best come from the Black Sea during the fall, a.k.a. 'hamsi season'.

Kokoreç - Originally a dish brought by nomadic Turks from Central Asia, kokoreç essentially consists of lamb or goat intestines wrapped in seasoned offal and stuffed with minced internal organs, which is then wrapped around a skewer and grilled. The stuffed intestines are then chopped into little pieces and seasoned with lemon, olive oil, oregano,salt and pepper, and served inside flat bread or on a plate with pickles and garnish. It may not sound appetizing, but it's quite good.

Lahmacun - Also known as 'Turkish pizza, the lahmacun is a soft oval of thin, slightly crisped dough covered with spicy sauce and mincemeat. It is served with greens and a lemon slice. You basically pile all the garnish you desire on top, roll it up like a burrito, and chow down.

Sarma - Sarmas, or 'dolmas' (both terms mean 'a stuffed thing'), refer to a variety of finger foods that feature some sort of filling inside some sort of organic wrap. This includes stuffed capsicum, stuffed eggplant, etc. However, the 'sarma' or 'dolma' generally applies to stuffed grape or cabbage leaves. These look like stubby, wet, loosely-rolled green or trans-

parent cigars. They are addictingly delicious. They come in two main varieties:
1) "kıyma," which is stuffed with mince meat, onion, pine nuts, spices rice and olive oil, and then served warm with yogurt; and 2) the same thing without meat, with some extra herbs and spices.

Manta - Manta are basically miniature dumplings. They are filled with some variety of minced meat or potato, which is then folded up in dough and either boiled or steamed and covered with a dollop of yogurt, melted butter and garlic sauce. Manta originated in the Turkic homelands near modern Mongolia and spread throughout Central Asia by migrating nomads, who could carry them frozen or dried and then boil them over a camp fire.

Baklava - These rich little pastries are formed of thin sheets of unleavened flour dough filled with crushed nuts and syrup or honey. They are a sweet dish found in many varieties throughout the lands of the former Ottoman Empire. The best, however, is said to be the pistachio baklava of Gaziantep, which can be found in select baklava shops throughout Istanbul. Mezes - Mezes are little dishes similar to Spanish tapas. They include favorites such as eggplant dip, halloumi, calamari,

hummus, hot pepper paste with walnuts, kalamata olives, pilaki and octopus, and countless others. The best place to eat mezes is in a meyane, accompanied by friends and a glass of raki.



The best way to experience this great variety of Turkish cuisine would be to take a food tour of Istanbul.

Discover Istanbul's culinary delights on a evening food tour of the capital. 



# Enjoy Tea and Coffee at Piyer Loti Hill


Julien Viaud known as 'Pierre Loti', a French naval officer and novelist who lived between 1850-1923, made his first visit to Istanbul at the age of 26.

He was so enchanted by the Ottoman culture and beauty of Istanbul, he became a regular visitor to the city. During his visits, he was staying at Eyüp district which is by the Golden Horn bay. He fell in love with an Ottoman lady and named one of his novels with her name, Aziyadé.

Loti has written another book, La Turquie Agonisante (Turkey in Agony) and

has been regarded as a sympathiser of the Ottomans. He was welcomed by the Sultan Mehmet Reşat on one of his visits with an official ceremony. Later in 1921, the new parliament sent him message of gratitude for his support of the Independence War and named an avenue and a coffee house on Eyüp hill with his name. The hill with a beautiful panoramic view of the Golden Horn and the historical peninsula is still called as 'Pierre Loti Hill'.




# Explore the Turkish Rug Techniques at the W/shop in Cappadocia

The international popularity of Turkish rugs began in the 13th century, when Marco Polo recorded the beauty and quality of the Seljuk rugs he saw in Anatolia. It is believed that certain weaving techniques were brought to Anatolia via the Seljuk Empire in the 12th century. Turkish rugs began appearing in Western paintings in the 15th and 16th centuries, and were often depicted either beneath the feet of the Virgin Mary or as table coverings. Traditionally, hand made rugs reflect both ancient patterns and the weaver's personal style or wishes. Once the traditional motifs are memorized, the weaver can combine them in a way that tells a story to one who understands the symbols used Cappadocia is one of the few places that this tradition of weaving rugs with old techniques and motifs is still being practiced. In other commercialized areas unfortunately many are woven into redesigned patterns, and are no longer a direct expression of the weaver's creativity.

#### Ceramic Course by Masters in Cappadocia

Throughout history, humanity has always been resourceful. They took the features and benefits of the landscape and used it to their advantage, whether it was building castles on hills for an optimum view of their approaching enemy or building settlements and villages near a source of water.

The small town of Avanos is no exception to this rule. It is well known throughout Turkey for its production of clay products. Hundreds of the village men are skilled in making pots, plates, wine holders, and even ashtrays and chess sets.

They are pottery masters and their skills have mostly been handed down from generation to generation. The roots of their profession lie in the nearby red river that flows through the town.

The Kizilirmak (Red river) is aptly named because of the red clay that lies on its banks. Locals of Avanos have been taking the clay since the Hittite period and using it to make household products.





# Nargile; "Turkish Style Hookah"

The nargile (NAHR-gee-leh), or Turkish water pipe, has for centuries been an icon of Eastern café culture. By forcing tobacco smoke through water, the nargile partially filters tar and particulates from smoke, in addition to cooling it. Also called a hookah or hubble-bubble, the nargile became popular in Turkey during the 1700s, at the height of the Ottoman Empire, and by the 19th century its plea-

sures had been discovered by European high society. After World War II, most smokers switched to cigarets. But now the nargile is back--and an increasingly trendy social activity in the coffee-house cultures of Spain, Sweden, Britain, and Asia, as well as the U.S.A. In this part you can see nargiles and nargile instructions.






# Discover the Cappadocia with Bicycle Tour

Three millions years ago violent eruptions of Mt. Erciyas (3916m) and Mt.Hasan (3300m) covered the surroundings plateau of Cappadocia with tuff, a soft stone comprised of lava, ash and mud. The wind and rain have eroded this brittle rock and created a surrealist landscape of rock cones, capped pinnacles and fretted ravines, in colours that range from warm reds and gold's to cool greens and greys. Goreme is one of those rare regions in the world where the works of man blend into the natural surroundings. During Byzantine times chapels and monasteries were hollowed out of the rock, their

ochre-toned frescoes reflecting the hues of the surrounding landscape. Even today troglodyte dwellings in the rock cones and village houses of volcanic tuff merge harmoniously into the landscape. Cappadocia is also natural wonders and unique area in the world with its history. We bike, exploring the surreal landforms of the Goreme valleys and enjoying the colorful blaze.
